## WHAT'S INVOLVED

Plasterers make, apply and fix the internal linings and facades of commercial and domestic buildings, including decorative and protective coverings made of plasterboard, fibre cement or similar materials.

Plasterers may perform the following tasks in both domestic and commercial markets:

- measure room walls, work out sheet layout and install insulation
- measure and mark cutting lines on sheet
- cut plasterboard, lift and position panels, and nail, screw / glue them to walls, ceilings or battens
- prepare corner panel mouldings (cornice), ceiling centres and other plaster fittings
- cover joints and nail holes with wet plaster or sealing compounds then finish the surface
- fix precast cornices and panel mouldings, ceiling centres and other plaster fittings
- apply finishing coats of plaster to give a smooth finish or decorative texture
- install fire-rated wall / ceiling systems
- spray fibrous materials over surfaces to be covered
- install acoustic walls and treatments
- render exterior walls and moulds
- make fibrous plaster moulds
- Install facades
- Install suspended ceilings
- Install stud and track systems

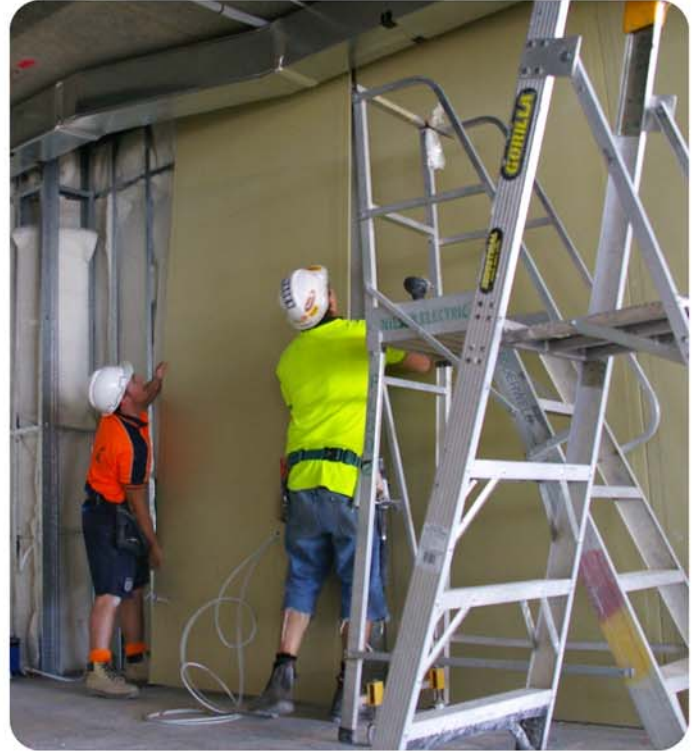

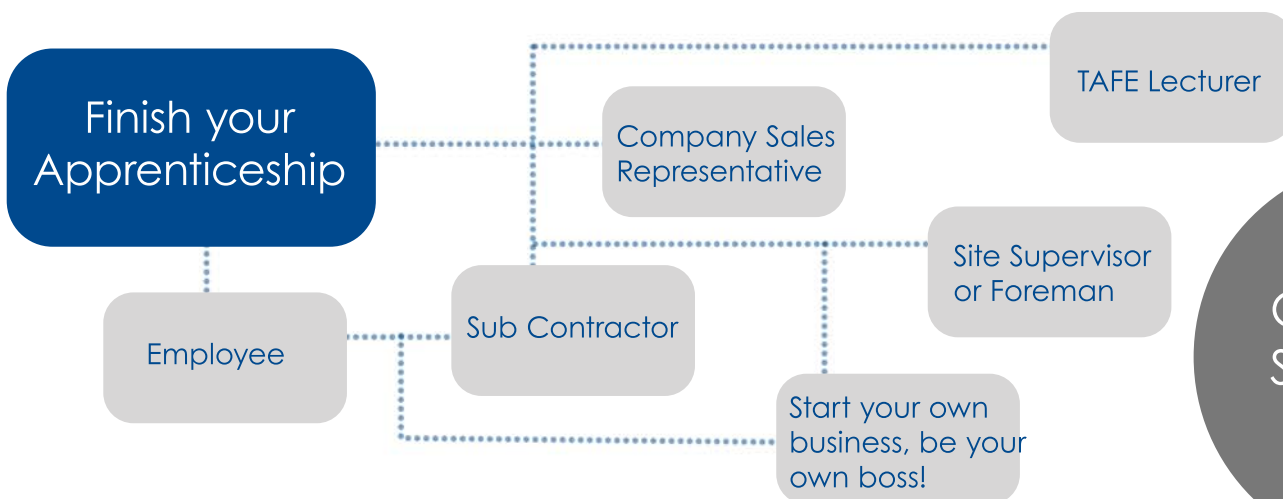
